Subject:

Sealco QR-1 Valve

Models Affected: Units listed in enclosed document with Sealco QR-1 valve

Note: Under certain maintenance/repair conditions the Sealco Valve can exhaust quicker than expected.

Instructions:

- 1. Locate QR-1 valve(s) on Tractor and/or Trailer.
 - a. On the Tractor the QR-1 valve will be located under center catwalk on head rack on the rear of the center cross member on driver side of tractor between the axles.
 - b. On the Trailer the QR-1 valve will be located on the rear of the center cross member on driver side of trailer between the axles.
- Identified QR-1 valve referenced in enclosed pictures. Before removing Sealco QR-1 valve make sure your dump valve switch is in off position if your trailer has a dump valve installed.
- 3. Remove Sealco QR-1 valve and replace with Bendix QR-1 valve, will need to retain fittings from original QR-1 valve to reuse fittings.
- 4. Attach original fittings from QR-1 valve to the replacement Bendix QR-1 valve.
- 5. Once installed Bendix QR-1 valve make sure there is no air leaking from fittings.
- 6. Check the function of the Lift kit and Dump valve after installation.
